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PROFILE

Senior systems engineer and developer with 25+ years shipping production Linux, from bare metal and firmware to the browser. Co-founder of **Devuan**, the systemd-free Debian fork, and author of its Amprolla package-repository infrastructure.

Two specialisms set this work apart. The first is **clean-room reverse engineering**: implementing undocumented protocols from black-box packet capture alone — most recently a four-platform Bigscreen VR remote-desktop agent built entirely from network observation. The second is **self-hosted AI and GPU infrastructure**: local multimodal model orchestration across NVIDIA, AMD and Intel hardware behind OpenAI-compatible APIs, multi-provider brokering, and agent/MCP tooling.

Equally comfortable owning a product end to end or being the specialist called in when a closed protocol, a stubborn daemon, or a model that must run on your own hardware is blocking everything else.

Self-hosted AI assistant and the agent infrastructure around it — much of it authored autonomously by the agents themselves.

- **hermes-node-gateway** — routes between the Hermes/Lisa agent and its device nodes
- **hermes-node-agent** — the core agent runtime
- **hermes-node-android** / **openclaw-android-node** — agent nodes for Android (Kotlin)
- **hermes-node-chrome** — Chrome extension letting the agent drive the browser
- **hermes-3tier-mempalace-memory** — rolling local memory plus a MemPalace long-term store
- **clawphone** — centralised job-queue MCP server coordinating multiple agents. FastAPI, Redis/SQLite
- **MCP server fleet** — 40+ Model Context Protocol servers giving agents live structured access to space and sky data, weather and environment, transport and logistics, policy and government records, OSINT and security, and research corpora
